► WHO NEEDS TO SUBMIT A PORTFOLIO?

New applicants planning to study the **Diploma of Photography and Digital Imaging (CUA50920)** without prior completion of the Certificate IV in Photography and Digital Imaging are required to submit a portfolio of relevant creative work and complete an interview, before allowed entry into the program.

► HOW DO I BOOK AN INTERVIEW AND SUBMIT MY PORTFOLIO?

Diploma of Photography applicants are required to submit a digital portfolio prior to arranging an interview. Once your portfolio has been assessed, we will contact you to arrange a suitable time for an interview.

Before booking an interview, we recommend you put in an application or 'register your interest' for the course through the <u>CIT website</u>. This allows us to update you on your progress, and keep you informed about upcoming information and enrolment sessions for photography courses.

You will find out during the interview whether you have been accepted into the Diploma.

► WHAT SHOULD I INCLUDE IN MY PORTFOLIO?

Portfolio Requirements

Applicants are required to submit at least 15 JPEG image files or provide a link to their website. The images should indicate a strong industry background and/or previous training.
